

The Minco Chamber of Commerce is pleased to announce The Minco Honey Festival Craft Show will return to the 4 Minco School buildings, the gym, café, AG building and bus barn, 311 S 6th Street (6th & Burt), Minco, OK 73059. We are looking forward to a successful festival and pray the weather cooperates! The Minco School buildings offer bathroom facilities, dependable heat and adequate parking availability.

TIMES

The festival will be held from 9:00 a.m. ~ 4:00 p.m., please come prepared to stay until 4:00 p.m.

PRICE & PAYMENT

8 x 10 booth spaces are available at \$75 each, maximum of 2 booths per vendor but these will be very limited. New Vendors will be allowed one booth. Booth spaces are limited to increase variety for customers. Half booths may be available at \$40 each, a booth and half (if available) at \$120 and two booths together are \$160. Applications will not be considered unless payment & pictures are included.

PICTURES & PRIORITIES

Applications will not be considered without pictures. Please send (ONLY) 2 pictures that are a good representation of your crafts. In an effort to provide variety the type of vendors will be limited and chosen on a first come, first serve basis. We give arts & crafts priority and will limit food and direct sales. It is important to return application early, filled out completely and with pictures and payment. Prior vendors will be assigned by the end of September and then the remaining booths will be opened up to new vendors the first of October.

SET-UP

Each vendor must provide their own set-up; tables, chairs, etc. Set up times are Friday, December 5, 2025, 5:00 ~ 7:00 p.m. and/or Saturday, December 6th, 2025, 7:00 ~ 8:30 a.m. PLEASE do not show up early. Unload quickly and move your vehicle, before setting up your booth, to make the loading/unloading available to the next vendor and to avoid traffic congestion.

PARKING

On the day of the festival, please park across the street at the Minco First Baptist Church parking lot so that the parking lot of the school will be available for customers. If you are in the AG BUILDING or Bus Barn you will be able to unload and park behind those buildings.

OKLAHOMA SALES TAX INFORMATION

We are required by the Oklahoma Tax Commission to obtain a permit for the fair and provide Vendor information including your email. The Oklahoma Tax Commission will reach out to you by email with instructions to file your taxes online, either using your federal ID number or your social security number. In an effort to maintain the high standards of our community and to produce a quality craft show, the CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, reserves the right to limit the number of booths assigned to each vendor and to monitor your booth. You may be asked to remove anything deemed vulgar, suggestive or not in good taste. (Including but not limited to: weapons, knives, swords, guns, etc.) To maintain a good selection of arts & crafts, only a limited number of food or direct sale vendors will be accepted and will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. Upon acceptance of your application, a registration confirmation will be emailed to you only after your registration fee is received by the Chamber of Commerce. Please mail this application and your fee by October 1, 2025 (we are often full by September).
